Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the creation of tourism boards to underpin youth employment policy

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas European tourism clearly has great potential for growth and development, enabling it to compete highly effectively at international level;
- B. whereas the relevant economic data show that that tourism is of major importance for successful job creation, especially for young people;
- C whereas the European Parliament has already adopted a number of major resolutions on tourism;
- 1 Considers it necessary to reiterate that the development of international tourism should be considered a priority issue;
- 2. Calls for legislative provisions governing the tourism industry through the creation of tourism boards to underpin youth employment policy.
