# Motion for a Parliament resolution on youth entrepreneurship in the renewable energy sector

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas solar energy has the best potential for satisfying humanity's future energy needs in the long-term by simultaneously contributing to fighting climate change;
- B. whereas sector surveys provide proof that the use of photovoltaic systems in Europe is rising sharply, also giving confidence to the reference market;
- C. whereas competition and the lowering of costs foster growth and international interest in this source of alternative energy;
- D. whereas the size of the productive, commercial and environmental aspects of the sector could represent a real opportunity for employment and investment, especially for youth entrepreneurship;
- 1. Believes that greater attention should be paid to this issue, which should be regarded as a priority;
- 2. Broposes an intervention to the Commission to organise programmes and financing for youth entrepreneurship in the renewable energy sector.
