Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the adoption of new legislation on initiatives to foster cultural entrepreneurship

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas international tourism is in constant need of new entrepreneurial projects to maximise the potential of its resources;
- B. whereas seminars held in various EU Member States are intended to train participants on cultural entrepreneurship, as that is considered fundamental to new international tourism initiatives;
- C. whereas Europe has a real wealth of cultural and tourist routes, even if some are smaller and not that well-known;
- D. whereas new training courses that make use of all the tools available to interpret current affairs, developing awareness and existing skills, are more effective in preparing participants for the challenges of the market;
- 1. Calls on the Commission to initiate legislation that fosters cultural and tourism entrepreneurship effectively in an effort to stimulate development, even in regional areas which are not that well-known but are of considerable cultural and historical value.
