Motion for a European Parliament resolution on new rules and regulations to protect small savers

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the EU banking union is turning out to be a real disaster; whereas the measures taken so far continue to penalise uninformed and innocent savers, in addition to the national credit institutions of small and medium-sized Member States themselves;
- B. whereas no specific measures have been taken to safeguard the economy, and small savers above all;
- C. whereas some Member States have attempted to alleviate the impact, mostly on small savers, by adopting ineffective legislative measures;
- D. whereas individual bondholders are apparently among those at risk, when the EU banking union should, in theory, be protecting them;
- 1. Believes that greater attention should again be paid to such an issue, which should be viewed as a priority;
- 2. Proposes that urgent action be taken to protect the EU's small and medium investors.
