Motion for a European Parliament resolution on regulations concerning the use of personal data for commercial purposes on the digital market

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the personal data held by large IT firms and on the Internet concern each one of us; whereas they are often used improperly and inappropriately;
- B. whereas the aim of existing regulations is to protect the confidentiality of these data only in formal terms, while protection is actually required in relation to the commercial use of the data, whether authorised or not, with the privacy of each one of us being subordinated to the interests and profits of the usual multinationals in the sector;
- 1. Considers it vital to create increased awareness of this issue;
- 2. Calls on the Commission to review the regulations concerning the use of personal data for commercial purposes on the digital market.
