Motion for a European Parliament resolution on providing incentives for the use of organic waste to produce clean energy

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the use of certain forms of renewable energy by European farms could represent a new system of farm management, leading to a reduction of costs and of the relevant environmental impact;
- B. whereas organic waste from food production, for example from citrus fruits and olives, are increasingly a vital source for the production of clean energy;
- C. whereas the promotion of waste for energy production would reduce the additional costs relating to the disposal of such waste;
- D. whereas data concerning production by biogas installations shows how this technology works well with the help of organic waste;
- 1. Proposes that the Commission draw up relevant legislative proposals to provide incentives for the use of organic waste to produce clean energy.
