### European Parliament resolution on the issue of migration and jihadist infiltration

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the Prime Minister of Poland, Beata Szydło, has stated that her country would no longer participate in the EU migrant allocation programme as a result of the terrorist attacks in Brussels;
- B. whereas, in Ms Szydło's opinion, the Brussels attacks show that the EU has lost whatever control it had over the migration crisis;
- C. whereas under the quota-based migrant allocation system, Poland had been forced to accept 6 500 refugees from Italy and Greece, a quota that the government promptly refused following the Paris attacks in November 2015;
- 1. Calls on the Council, the Commission and the Counter-Terrorism Coordinator to seriously address the issue of migration and jihadist infiltration, following the example of the Polish Government, which has decided not to take the risk of welcoming individuals whose true identity is often difficult to establish.
