Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the implications of the Dutch referendum for the EU-Ukraine Association Agreement

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas an overwhelming majority of the Dutch people have voted against the ratification of the EU-Ukraine association agreement, which would open the way for free trade and the free movement of persons between Ukraine and the EU;
- B. whereas anyone with even the most basic understanding of the nature of democracy should come to the logical conclusion that the agreement cannot therefore be brought into force, especially since the Member States must unanimously agree on texts of this kind;
- 1. Calls on the European Commission to take the requisite steps to kill off the EU-Ukraine association agreement.
