Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the dangers posed by the influx of migrants, especially to women and homosexuals

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas, having claimed that it was necessary to take in migrants, the Commission has set up mechanisms to distribute these illegals among the Member States;
- B. whereas, however, migrants already taken in have demonstrated their inability to adapt to life in our societies, in particular through their actions in harassing and persecuting women and homosexuals;
- 1. Calls on the Commission to catalogue precisely how women's and homosexuals' rights have deteriorated in areas where migrants have been taken in;
- 2. Calls on the Commission as a precautionary measure at least to halt its policy of taking in migrants.
