Motion for a European Parliament resolution on employee profit-sharing schemes

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas today all the EU Member States are implementing policies designed to reduce employers' social security contributions and corporation taxes, thereby increasing firms' profit margins;
- B. whereas these reductions in charges are being funded to large extent by increases in the taxes paid by households, and whereas employees are being denied wage increases;
- C. whereas a firm's employees play a key role in generating its profits, whereas strengthening the employee-firm relationship is likely to increase productivity, and whereas firms must also play their part in improving living conditions;
- 1. Calls on the Commission to consider ways of fostering employee profit-sharing schemes.
