Motion for a European Parliament resolution on a points-based immigration system

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas Australia has recorded virtually no arrival of refugees for several months and claims it knows of no migrant deaths at sea;
- B. whereas Australia has introduced a very strict migration policy to deal with illegal immigration and has in parallel with this put in place a policy of selective immigration based on points awarded according to several criteria which together determine the profile of immigrants that the Australian Government wishes to accept;
- 1. Calls on the Commission to start drafting a report on the merits and limits of a points system of selective immigration for use by the Member States.
