Motion for a European Parliament resolution on Erasmus+ and mobility

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the European training programme Erasmus+ is a key instrument for promoting the EU among young graduates;
- B. whereas it has been a huge success success and presents a number of advantages from the European point of view, given that it reinforces the single market and encourages mutual qualification recognition and the alignment of competences;
- C. whereas it is a means of consolidating the principle of increased workforce mobility;
- 1. Raises concerns about the possibility that the programme could be abused in such a way that it creates a mobile under-proletariat whose social rights are reduced to their simplest form;
- 2. Calls on the Commission to carry out a study on the ways in which the system is likely to be abused and to put in place all the safeguards necessary to maintain adequate social rights.
