on pre-accession aid for Turkey

Motion for a European Parliament resolution on pre-accession aid for Turkey

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the EU is providing support for the economic, social and territorial development of Turkey under the instrument for pre-accession assistance (IPA II);
- B. whereas that aid, which should stand at close to EUR 800 million in 2017, is intended both to smooth Turkey's path towards accession to the EU and to provide funding for the migration agreement reached with the country;
- C. whereas recent events and the Turkish authorities' slide into authoritarianism invalidate those plans;
- D. whereas Turkey is not fit to join the EU;
- 1. Calls on the Commission, the Council and the Member States to consider drastically cutting accession aid for Turkey and to stop paying the EU contribution to the facility for migrants in Turkey.
