Motion for a European Parliament resolution on European External Action Service (EEAS) expenses

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the very existence of the European External Action Service (EEAS) is an attack on the sovereignty of Member States, which have exclusive competence in diplomatic matters;
- B. whereas EU external action is not only detrimental, but also needlessly expensive;
- C. whereas the EEAS's spending on property rental charges and ancillary costs are expected to come to more than EUR 160 million in 2017;
- D. whereas external policy should remain exclusively a Member State matter;
- 1. Calls on the Commission and the Council to cut this pointless spending to no more than is strictly necessary.
