Motion for a European Parliament resolution on Mycobacterium tuberculosis

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Article 168 of the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,
- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas Mycobacterium tuberculosis (the 'disease') is the most lethal of all curable infections, causing more than two million deaths per year worldwide;
- B. whereas the disease is spreading due to the lack of access to quadruple therapy and whereas it can develop a multi-resistant strain from contact with antituberculosis drugs;
- C. whereas the disease mainly develops in poor countries and among people with HIV, and whereas the Union is experiencing a high migratory influx from countries in the Middle East and sub-Saharan Africa;

encourages the Commission to:

- 1. Ensure the protection of all Member States against the disease in particular by developing its prevention;
- 2. Support scientific research on the disease and allow the emergence of new treatments.
