Motion for a European Parliament resolution on aerotoxic syndrome

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Article 168 of the TFEU,
- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas a number of doctors have observed neurological and neuromuscular symptoms reflecting white matter degeneration among airline crew members, whose effects memory loss and difficulties with maintaining attention and concentration are of great concern to airline pilots;
- B. whereas passenger airline pilots and crew are exposed to fumes from oil used in jet engines containing toxic substances such as organophosphates that, in the event of a leak and after heating are liable to emit toxic smoke;
- C. whereas many toxicologists and toxic chemical experts have observed links between aerotoxic syndrome and the chemicals sprayed in the passenger compartment of commercial aircraft;
- D. whereas aerotoxic syndrome is not yet recognised by national medical authorities;

invites the Commission to:

- 1. Encourage research into the syndrome with a view to evaluating the risks related to air toxicity in aircraft;
- 2. Call on the medical authorities of Member States, if necessary, to recognise this syndrome.
