Motion for a European Parliament resolution on the lack of transparency regarding the Commission's travel expenses

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 133 of its Rules of Procedure,
- A. whereas the Spanish NGO *Access Info* published the initial findings of its inquiry into the staggering sums spent by Commissioners on business trips;
- B. whereas in January and February 2016, the travel expenses of Commissioners amounted to EUR 550 000, and that, for example, the bill for Mr Juncker's two-day trip to Rome by private jet was EUR 26 000;
- C. whereas, despite many requests by citizens, the Commission has refused to publish the travel costs for the year as a whole.
- 1. Calls on the Commission to ensure full transparency as regards its travel expenses.
