## WRITTEN QUESTION E-3277/02 by Astrid Lulling (PPE-DE) and Reinhold Messner (Verts/ALE) to the Commission

Subject: Production methods for Maltese quality wines

Following the Commission's answer to the written question E-2267/02<sup>1</sup> it has come to our knowledge that the European Union is prepared to concede to Malta two major departures from fundamental labelling principles for a transitional period:

- the addition of sugar in the production of wine something unheard of in a Southern European country; and
- the granting of a quality wine Malta PSR status to a wine produced in Malta from grapes or grape must imported from overseas.
- 1. Can the Commission confirm this?
- 2. If so, can the Commission guarantee that this transitional period will not put regular Maltese winemakers at a serious disadvantage?
- 3. Is there no danger of this creating a precedent vis-à-vis other Mediterranean winemaking nations?
