Subject: Harmonised interpretation of the provisions of Regulation (EC) No 561/2006

In his answer to my question to the Commission (P-2121/07), Commissioner Barrot indicated that he favoured a harmonised interpretation of the provisions of Regulation (EC) No 561/2006¹, whilst also indicating that he did not intend to actively promote the establishment of such a harmonised interpretation. - 1. Is it correct that the Commission has convened the comitology committee pursuant to Article 24 of Regulation (EC) No 561/2006?
- 2. What outcome is the committee intended to achieve, and within what time frame?
- 3. To what extent does the committee include members who are also members of CORTE?
- 4. Is it correct that CORTE, together with the IRU and ETF, is working on formulating proposals for the harmonised interpretation and implementation of Regulation (EC) No 561/2006?
- 5. How will the committee deal with the results produced by CORTE?
