## Question for written answer E-006411/2014 to the Commission Rule 130 Franck Proust (PPE)

Subject: Icelandic volcanos - crises in the skies over Europe

The threat of a new volcanic eruption in Iceland seems to be receding and with it, that of Europe's air traffic once more being brought to a standstill as happened in 2010.

- 1. What mechanisms are there in place at present at European level to manage these crisis situations (forwarding of information, rerouting, etc.)?
- 2. What assistance is offered so grounded passengers can reach their final destination (in Europe or outside it) in spite of everything?
- 3. Did the 2010 crisis lead to European air traffic control authorities improving their capacity to respond to these crises and emergency situations? If so, how?
