Question for written answer E-006437/2014 to the Commission Rule 130 Fernando Maura Barandiarán (ALDE)

Subject: Humanitarian crisis in Irak, South Sudan, Syria and the Central African Republic

On 13 August 2014 the United Nations took the unprecedented step of declaring a level 3 – which is the highest level – humanitarian crisis in Irak, South Sudan, Syria and the Central African Republic. Given the scale and complexity of the current humanitarian catastrophe:

- 1. What steps has the Commission taken to mobilise additional resources in the form of goods, funds and assets to ensure a more effective response to the humanitarian needs of the populations forced to leave their homes?
- 2. Leaving aside individual action taken by some Member States, what mechanism for coordinated external action has the Commission organised?
- 3. What work has the EU's Representative to the United Nations been carrying out in this regard?
