Subject: TTIP's impact on agriculture

Negotiations are currently underway on the introduction of a number of trade and free-trade agreements with various countries around the world (CETA, China, Japan, TTIP, agreements with countries and groups of countries in Africa, etc.).

With regard to the TTIP, a study published by Parliament's Directorate-General for Internal Policies entitled 'Risks and opportunities for the EU agri-food sector in a possible EU-US trade agreement' was presented at the AGRI Committee meeting of 3 September. This study only looks at the trade aspect.

- 1. Has the Commission assessed how many small and medium-sized farms are set to disappear?
- 2. Has the Commission calculated how many direct jobs on farms and indirect jobs in related activities are set to disappear?
- 3. Has the Commission assessed the health-related implications that harmonisation will have?
