Subject: The right to register foreign workers

It appears that Poland is dissatisfied with the Danish RUT Register, which ensures that the Danish authorities are able to locate undertakings and check that they are not practising social dumping.

If the Commission were to declare this registration option illegal, it would become well-nigh impossible to protect against social dumping, and this would have fatal consequences for the Danish labour market.

1. Does the Commission agree that it is important to combat social dumping and promote regular pay and working conditions?
2. If the Commission rules that the Danish register is illegal, how does it suppose Denmark can set up a system enabling us to know who is working in Denmark?
