Subject: Implementation of the White Paper on Sport

The White Paper on Sport (COM(2007)0391) presented by the Commission in 2007 provided for specific measures to be implemented under the 'Pierre de Coubertin' Action Plan. The Commission anticipated the creation of a European label for schools which encourage involvement in sports. Has such a label been created? How many schools in the EU had been awarded this label by 2014?

One of the stated objectives of the 2007 White Paper on Sport was to facilitate the sharing of our values between the Member States, including through a number of existing programmes. The Europe for Citizens programme was implemented from 2007 to 2013, and its objective was to promote an active civil society in Europe.

1. What share of the support has been allocated to civil society organisations which promote or make use of sport in their activities?
2. How does the Commission plan to incorporate the objectives of the White Paper on Sport into the Erasmus+ programme, which is dedicated to education, training and sport?
