Subject: Possibility of electoral fraud at the 2009 European Parliament elections

For the 2009 European Parliament elections, many EU citizens living in a country other than their own received a voting card both from their home country and from their country of residence. As there are over 10 million Europeans in EU Member State which are not their own, this is a serious problem which may influence the outcome of elections.

1. Will the Commission say what was done to prevent this problem from arising at the 2014 European Parliament elections, and whether there was a measurable impact?
2. Does the Commission furthermore agree that it is problematic, from a democracy point of view, if voters can vote in more than one country?
