Subject: Safety requirements for baby changing tables

It is estimated that every year in the EU, approximately 5 500 children aged 0-4 years are involved in changing table accidents that are serious enough to require a hospital visit.

The European safety standard EN 12221-2:2008 sets out safety requirements for changing tables for domestic use.

- 1. Do these safety requirements also apply to changing tables in public facilities?
- 2. If not, are there any EU-wide requirements for the safety of changing tables for public use, and would the Commission consider proposing such requirements if they do not already exist?
- 3. In addition, what action has the Commission taken to ensure that these requirements are adequately implemented and monitored?
