Question for written answer E-007984/2014 to the Commission Rule 130 José Blanco López (S&D)

Subject: Vigo-Oporto high-speed rail link

In its answer to written question E-006533/2014, the Commission stated that it had been notified that the Vigo-Oporto high-speed rail link was not going to be constructed in the period 2007-2013 and that the European funding intended for this project had therefore been re-injected in the following TEN-T call, 'following which it has been re-committed to projects currently being implemented'.

In light of the foregoing:

- 1. When did the national authorities inform the Commission that the project to construct the Vigo-Oporto high-speed rail link had been abandoned and what reasons were given for this decision?
- 2. Should it be understood from the Commission's answer that the funds that had previously been committed were then fully de-committed from this project and therefore that these funds have been set aside for projects other than the Vigo-Oporto high-speed rail link?
- 3. Have the authorities in Spain and Portugal informed the Commission of their intention to maintain this project and/or have they requested new European funding for the Vigo-Oporto high-speed rail link?
