Subject: Russian embargo: future measures to help European farmers

The Russian embargo is having disastrous consequences for European farmers. While the Commission reacted rapidly by making a package of EUR 125 million available for fruit and vegetables, supplemented recently by a further EUR 165 million and a better distribution of funds among the Member States, these measures are merely responding to an immediate need, and the crisis is far from over.

- 1. Is the Commission devising any long-term measures in this area?
- 2. When this crisis is over, producers will also need help to regain the markets they have lost. Is the Commission giving any thought to this matter?
- 3. Finally, if such measures are adopted, from what budget outside the agriculture budget will they be funded?
