Subject: Internet tax in Hungary

More than ten thousand people have demonstrated in Budapest against the planned introduction of an Internet tax in Hungary. The speakers demanded the withdrawal of the corresponding draft law.

Under the proposals this tax is to be set at HUF 150, i.e. EUR 0.49, per gigabyte of data. The planned tax would be unique in Europe.
