Question for written answer E-009411/2014 to the Commission Rule 130 José Blanco López (S&D)

Subject: European financing for the cities of A Coruña and Vigo

Since the entry of Spain into the European Union, Spain and Galicia have benefited from Community solidarity funding as one of the main recipients of monies from Structural Funds and the Cohesion Fund.

Further to my question E-005993/2014 concerning Galicia and other autonomous communities in Spain, can the European Commission break down, for each multi-year financing period, what proportion of the more than EUR 20 billion that my region has received from European funds since the accession of Spain into the EU in 1986 has gone to the cities of A Coruña and Vigo?

Can it also estimate the amounts that both cities will receive from European solidarity funding in the next period of the programme, from 2014 to 2020?

Which projects have been and will be the subject of financing and co-financing by the EU?
