Subject: Managing the presence of wolves: examples of best practice from the EU

In some European regions, the presence of wolf species poses serious problems of co-existence with livestock and human settlements.

In the light of the existing provisions of the LIFE+ Project, and as requested in my question E-003316/2014, can the Commission state whether it holds any statistical and survey data about compensation paid to livestock farmers, any livestock deaths, authorised hunting zones, movements and the numbers of wolf packs per Member State?
