Subject: Compatibility with EU guidelines on State aid for regional airports

As a result of the investment of ERDF funds, the San Javier airport in Murcia has facilities for over two million passengers and is a completely public and profitable airport.

In our view the petition that has been presented to the European Union on behalf of the Murcia International Airport at Corvera contains several false data, and, furthermore, we believe that there is a deliberate interest, with political support from the Autonomous Regional Community of Murcia (CARM), in avoiding the failure of the private airport project at Corvera.

Will the Commission carry out an audit or create a commission of inquiry to monitor simultaneously and in parallel the measures adopted by the Spanish government via the Ministry of Public Works and the airport administrator AENA, by which various regional development projects involving air transport were approved for the CARM, in order to determine whether or not such measures comply with the law?
