## Question for written answer E-009759/2014 to the Commission

Subject: 'Unblock Italy' decree - potential infringement proceedings

Article 5 of the so-called 'Unblock Italy' decree (Italian Legislative Decree No 133 of 12 September 2014) would appear to allow for considerable amendments to motorway concession contracts; however, the wording of this Article is unclear and could also permit significant extensions to the period of existing concessions.

In this context, account must be taken of Council Directive 93/37/EEC of 14 June 1993 concerning the coordination of procedures for the award of public works contracts, specifically Article 7(3)(d), and the pre-litigation procedure opened by the Commission on 17 October 2014 under the EU Pilot project – along with the consequent request for observations submitted to the Italian authorities.

- 1. Taking the above into consideration, can the Commission reveal the Italian authorities' response?
- 2. How does the Commission intend to intervene if incompatibility with European legislation is confirmed?
- 3. Does the Commission not believe that the above provision also constitutes a violation of European antitrust legislation and a distortion of competition within the motorway sector?
