Subject:     Proposals for adaptation of Regulation (EC) No 2201/2003

The Commission's report (COM(2014)0225 of 15 April 2014) related to Council Regulation (EC) No 2201/2003 of 27 November 2003 concerning jurisdiction and the recognition and enforcement of judgments in matrimonial matters and the matters of parental responsibility indicates that the regulation is a well-functioning instrument, but states that there is evidence based on data and preliminary feedback given by experts that existing rules could be improved.

1.    Has the Commission launched any policy evaluation of the existing rules and their impact on citizens?
2.    Does the Commission plan to take any further action and put forward proposals for adaptation to the Member States?
3.    What are the main factors identified by the Commission that require adaptation?
