Subject: Provisions on rest time for road haulage drivers

The Commission's Guidance Note 2 on Regulation 561/2006 provides that, when a vehicle is manned by more than one driver, a period of 45 minutes of the second driver's 'period of availability' can be regarded as 'break'.

Article 4(d) of Regulation 561/2006 defines 'break' as any period during which a driver may not carry out any driving or any other work and which is used exclusively for recuperation.

Article 4(f) of Regulation 561/2006 defines 'rest' as any uninterrupted period during which a driver may freely dispose of his time.

- 1. Does the Commission not consider that treating the 45-minute period of the second driver's availability as a 'break' denies the driver the possibility of free disposal of his time, in accordance with the definition?
- 2. How does the Commission intend to guarantee that the driver actually does benefit from such a break?
- 3. How does the Commission intend to guarantee the driver's right to decide to take his break freely, without negative treatment by his employer as a result of making this choice?
