Subject: Complaint against Spain for polluting the Ria de Pontevedra

A few days ago, the Commission announced that it had filed a complaint against Spain with the European Court of Justice for poor treatment of urban waste water in various locations, including the Galician municipalities of Pontevedra, Marin, Poio and Bueu.

Further to my Written Question E-007654/2014 on the visit by the European Parliament's Committee on Petitions to the Galician estuaries:

1. Can the Commission provide full details of the current complaint, as well as of other files relating to waste water treatment affecting Galicia?
2. Can it confirm that there is no threat to public health and say what problems persist and what measures still need to be taken by the authorities?
3. Can it say whether any European funding was used to improve water quality?
