Subject: The Ebola crisis

The Ebola virus will not spare a Europe that is not in control of its borders. Mireille d'Ornano questioned the regional director of the WHO responsible for Europe on this issue, who provided a calm response, due to the fact that all of the migrants would appear to be in good health.

However, although it is impossible and not very desirable to examine all of the people of Europe or to limit their movement within national territories so as to lessen the risk of contagion, it is essential and realistic, in contrast, to stem the influx of migrants, in particular illegal migrants, that is supported by the Commission.

What level of medical examination is required by the Commission and actually implemented at the borders, in particular in the administrative migrant holding centres?
