Subject: Transport of live animals to third countries

Council Regulation (EC) No 1/2005 on the protection of animals during transport sets out rules on the transport of live animals within the EU, including a requirement for drivers and handlers to have a certificate of competence. However, there have been reports that animal welfare rules are not always being upheld during the export of animals to third countries from some Member States.

- 1. What steps is the Commission taking to ensure that animals exported to third countries begin their journey in conditions that are consistent with EU rules?
- 2. What steps is the Commission taking to ensure that animal welfare rules relating to transport are upheld throughout the EU?
