Subject: Aid payments to Ukraine

In March 2014 the European Union announced that it was supporting Ukraine with an aid package worth EUR 11 billion, to avert the threat of bankruptcy. Of this total, EUR 3 billion is to be funded from the current EU budget, including EUR 1.4 billion in the form of subsidies and EUR 1.6 billion in loans. The balance of EUR 8 billion is to be pre-financed by the European Investment Bank and the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development.

- 1. How much of the prospective aid has been paid to the Government of Ukraine so far?
- 2. For what purposes is this financial aid actually used?
- 3. Can the Commission specify the nature and amounts of all financial resources going to Ukraine from the EU?
