Subject: Violence and sport

On 2 December 2014, a Deportivo de A Coruña supporter was murdered in Madrid by Club Atlético de Madrid fans. The causes and circumstances of this incident are not clear, although several sources say it happened in a large brawl.

The European Commission has held the EU Sport Forum 2014 in Milan, with the focus on discussing implementation of the Erasmus+: Sport programme. The Commission also has a full agenda concerning sport training, good governance and combating doping.

1. Can the Commission give details of its agenda for preventing and combating violence in sport?
2. Is the Commission considering the possibility of including violence prevention aspects in its sport training programmes?
3. Will the Commission support the inclusion of efforts to combat violence in the principle of integrity of sport recognised by the EU's Work Plan for Sport?
