Subject: Transparency - Transatlantic Treaty

With reference to the transatlantic treaty negotiations, all members of the European Parliament acknowledge that the process is opaque.

However, it seems that the documents relating to these negotiations have been accessible since a few weeks ago to some 40 MEPs, not including myself.

Consequently, could the Commission let me know the method of selection of the MEPs with access to the TAFTA documents, described by the Commission itself as highly confidential, despite the fact that this treaty will affect all economic and social stakeholders in EU Member States?
