Subject: Early school leaving

Member States want to reduce school drop-out rates to below 10 %. However, according to the 2013 report of the European Network of Education Councils conference, the percentage of young people leaving school early now stands at 12.8 %.

According to the same report, the main impact of early school leaving is youth unemployment. In 2011, 54.8 % of early school leavers were unemployed, but around 70 % intended to get a job and 'people without proper education lost their jobs during the crisis'.

- 1. Does the Commission have new data on school leaving in the EU?
- 2. What immediate action should be taken to minimise this phenomenon?
