Subject: VP/HR - Fair justice in Bolivia

In its resolution on fair justice in Bolivia of 20 November 2013¹, Parliament called on the European External Action Service (EEAS) to keep the cases of Előd Tóásó and Mario Tadić high on the agenda in its contacts with the Bolivian Government. On 28 August 2014, the UN Working Group on Arbitrary Detention issued Opinion No 28/2014 on the case of Mario Tadić, which establishes that his detention in Bolivia is arbitrary and calls on the Bolivian authorities to free him immediately.

1. What measures has the EEAS taken in this regard thus far, starting from Parliament's resolution of 20 November 2013?
2. What measures, if any, does the EEAS intend to take to end the violation of the rights of EU citizen Mario Tadić?
