Subject: Restricted tender procedure within the framework of the Erasmus + programme

In July 2014, the European Commission launched a restricted tender procedure, within the framework of the Erasmus + programme, with a view to supporting the implementation of reforms in higher education (EACEA 20/2014). The Commission's aim is to provide funding for projects that might foster a future proposal for reform of higher education at European level.

In particular, potential projects should be investigating ways of filling the gaps identified in the Bologna Process and described in the 2012 report on implementation of the Bologna Process. Total funding for the programme is EUR 1.8 million, with each project receiving funding at a grant rate of 80% and amounts ranging between EUR 15 000 and 180 000.

Can the European Commission provide information on the projects that have been accepted, the countries that have benefited and the amounts that have been awarded?
