Subject: Damage to the cultural heritage of Sasamón (Spain)

The cultural heritage of Sasamón (Spain) is in an alarming state of disrepair made worse by the floods which occurred in December 2013.

A few months ago, the Commission, in answer to a citizen, expressed its interest in this matter and argued that the authorities of Castile and León were stating that the necessary investments had been made for the restoration of this heritage and denied the urgency and poor condition of some of these historic buildings. Far from this being the case, the damage is becoming worse each day, which is why over the last year it has been included on the 'red list' drawn up by the Hispania Nostra association, and Spanish institutions are not intervening.

In view of this situation, I ask the Commission:

1. Is the Commission aware of the state of progress of the works financed with FEDER funds along the Cuatro Villas de Amaya route, which includes the town of Sasamón, which were due to have been completed in June 2014?
