Subject: Security situation in B&H

According to latest information from relevant sources in Bosnia and Herzegovina there are around 3 000 persons on the territory of B&H who could pose a threat to the security of Bosnia and Herzegovina, its neighbours and the European continent. The authorities say that, for reasons of poverty and government inefficiency, they are unable to respond to this complex security requirement. Having stayed in Bosnia and Herzegovina many times I know that, regardless of radical developments, there are also excellent examples of multiculturalism.

I ask the Commission:

1. What will it do to assist the authorities in Bosnia and Herzegovina, the Federation of Bosnia and Herzegovina and the Republic of Srpska to monitor suspicious persons and prevent terrorist acts?
2. What measures will the Commission take to help the authorities in Bosnia and Herzegovina to affirm the values of ethnic, linguistic and religious tolerance?
