Subject: Conflict of interest with senior EBRD official also heading Task Force for Greece

At the end of December a new Executive Director was appointed on behalf of the EU to the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (EBRD). Until the end of February, this senior official will still be Head of the Task Force for Greece.

1. How will the Commission guarantee that any appearance of a conflict of interest can be avoided, particularly since the person concerned was formerly Secretary-General of the EBRD, and will now be exclusively defending the interests of the EU?
2. What will happen afterwards with the Task Force for Greece, particularly since it has been stated that he is being transferred 'internally' in the interest of the service?
