Subject: Hayat Boumeddiene and Turkey

It has been reported in the press that French national Hayat Boumeddiene, one of the shooters in the Paris kosher supermarket attack in January 2015, passed through security at Istanbul's Atatürk International Airport without being challenged. Given the severity of her crimes, does the Commission intend to press the Turkish authorities on why such a dangerous individual was allowed to pass through their airport security without being questioned?
