Subject: VP/HR - The European Union in the Colombia peace process

According to information available in the media in Colombia, the Political and Security Committee of the European Union has expressed its willingness to discuss the technical, economic and political support the EU will offer the Government of Colombia once the peace agreement with the FARC-EP guerrillas has been concluded.

Clearly it will not be possible for this support to be provided while the European Union still views one of the parties (the FARC-EP guerrillas) as a terrorist group, in accordance with Council Common Position of 17 June 2002.

Is the High Representative taking steps to obtain a consensus among the Member States in order to remove FARC-EP from the European Union's list of terrorist groups?
