Subject: Flaws of EU migration policy

The budget for Frontex was reduced from EUR 115 million in 2011 to EUR 85 million in 2013, while migration flows have significantly increased as a result of the conflicts in North Africa and the Middle East. Moreover, in 2013, just five Member States accounted for 70 % of all immigration applications registered in the EU-28.

These figures clearly show that the current EU migration system consists of a patchwork with no internal coherence, no fair system for sharing responsibility and no visibility for citizens.

- 1. Does the EU support the creation of a common EU migration policy?
- 2. If so, what is the view of the new Commissioner, Dimitris Avramopoulos, on this lack of coherence on migration policies?
- 3. Will the Commission review the Frontex regulation to ensure compulsory contributions from all Member States to the agency's operations and budget?
